Player address confirmations: don't let your savings go to waste

There's another reason we need you to fill out the survey if you haven't already. Our energy provider partners need us to confirm that all players are still at the same address now as you were when you signed up for the competition. This is so that the electricity use data they provide (which we'll use to calculate the final scores) is accurate.

If you've already filled out the survey, you'll have ticked the box confirming your address. If you haven't filled it out yet: **PLEASE DO! If we don't receive your address confirmation, we will not be able to include your energy savings in the final score calculations**...so don't let your team down and risk not having your hard-earned savings not count in the final score tallies. Fill out the survey (and address confirmation question right at the beginning) today!

Energy Tip: Turn your power GREEN



Here's a tip that is not about saving energy but is great for the environment. No matter which electricity provider you're with, you can buy a certain percentage of **GreenPower** from them.

What is GreenPower? It's is a voluntary government-accredited program that enables your energy provider to purchase renewable energy with your support. Buying GreenPower effectively means you're buying zero emissions renewable energy: the few extra cents you pay in addition to your electricity account each day is invested in the renewable energy sector.

Why is this so important? Because around 90% of electricity used in Australia is still generated from the burning of fossil fuels such as coal and over 34% of Australia's carbon emissions come from electricity generation. This makes the electricity sector the biggest single contributor to Australia's greenhouse emissions. The benefit of switching to GreenPower-accredited renewable energy is that it does not burn fossil fuels.
