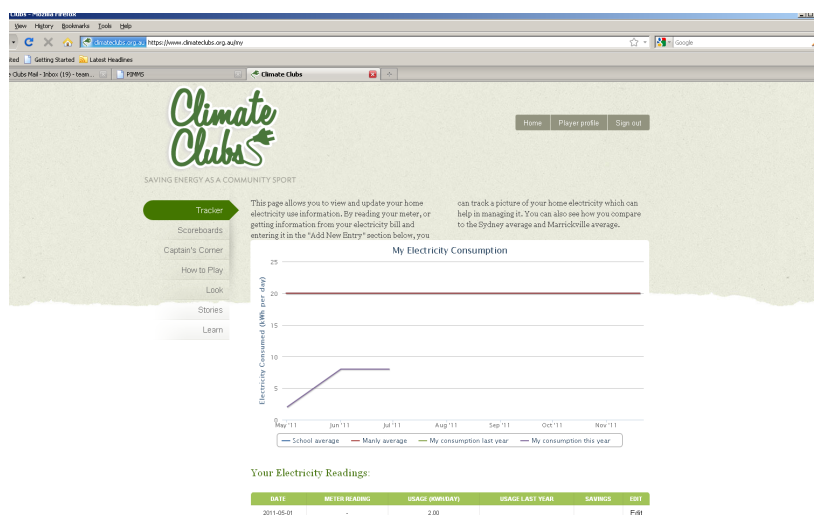
Help your school earn more points and win prizes

This is how:

Go to www.climateclubs.org.au:

- Click on the **Player Login** tab in the top right corner
- Enter your email and password (If you've forgotten your password, you can re-set it at login)
- Click on **Add New Entry** at the bottom of the *Your Electricity Readings* table (see screenshot of webpage below)
- Enter a new meter reading (our first competition update stepped you through how to read your electricity meter), or daily average (if you have received a bill recently this will be shown on your bill)
- Check the team and zone scoreboards to see how your update has changed the score!

When you follow the instructions above and update your electricity usage online, you automatically go into the draw to win fabulous prizes, such as **footy or cinema tickets** or an **Efergy home energy monitor**. The winner will be announced in next week's newsletter.

The Efergy monitor gives you real-time information about your electricity use, greenhouse gas emissions and cost of electricity used. Plus if you win, one of our fabulous electricians, **Tony Faughey** or **Luke Martin**, who are very kindly donating their time, will install your Efergy monitor for free in your own home.

"At our house we have been saving power. We have been turning off the lights. We have watched less TV and we have been reading more books. We don't open the windows in winter because it is cold."

"Gas is the way to go! I used to use reverse-cycle air conditioning for heating and it ate up energy. This winter we bought a gas heater and we've saved at least \$300 on our bills already. The gas heater keeps our house warmer for longer too. My three daughters and I are also using a timer in the shower because we have an electric hot water heater so we know keeping our showers shorter will save energy. Plus my daughter who is in Year 3 at Tregear runs around turning the lights off all the time if we leave them on!"
