## **Climate Clubs Awards Assemblies in December**

#### The Competition is over...what next?

Once we've tallied the final scores by early December, we will announce the winners! You'll receive a special Competition Update via email announcing the winners, plus the results will be up on our website, and we'll let all schools and Captains know directly. We'll also be coming out to every Climate Clubs school to do a presentation at an end of term assembly. See below for the prizes and how we're calculating the winners...

## **Climate Clubs Prizes**

In case you missed this in last week's update, here's what is up for grabs and how we will calculate the winners:

#### **Climate Clubs Cup Winner**

The Council area with the most savings points will receive the Climate Clubs Cup. This is based on aggregated total savings points of each club in that zone. Efficiency points are excluded from this calculation as the relative average electricity consumption can vary widely from one local government area to the next.

What do you win? Glory, fame and the beautiful Climate Clubs Cup!

#### **Climate Clubs Shields Winners**

To determine the winner of *The Manly Daily, Blacktown Advocate* and *Inner West Courier Shields*, total points – both efficiency and savings points – are aggregated at the club (team) level. The Club with the most points in their zone wins the shield.

What do you win? The shield for your area, plus there is a cash prize for the winning school in each zone. The Parents and Citizens Association of the winning school will receive \$500 first prize, AND if that Climate Club saves more than 10% of electricity compared to last year, then the prize doubles to \$1000!

### **Best and Fairest Player Awards**

A "best and fairest" player from each Club will be selected. This is awarded to the household that has the highest total score (combined efficiency and savings points) **and** has engaged with the competition by taking energy savings actions at home and updating their electricity use on the online Climate Clubs scoreboard at least once during the competition.

What do you win? A certificate and a fabulous family friendly prize (e.g. family pass to Taronga Zoo, family pass to your local pool, and other great prizes)

Plus ALL participating schools will receive Climate Clubs Certificates and a cheque for their school's P&C Association (the \$ amount = 3 cents x total kWh of electricity the Club has saved). This amounted to **over \$300** for each school in last year's competition.
